The Earls of Leicester’s repertoire, musical style, and dress pay homage to the early era of bluegrass. Truly a group of all-stars, The Earls of Leicester are Jerry Douglass, Berry Bales, Shawn Camp, Charlie Cushman, Johnny Warren and Jeff White. Between them they have over 17 Grammy Awards and 7 IBMA Awards – including three as “Entertainer of the Year.” Talking about his inspiration for forming the band, Jerry Douglas said: “Flatt and Scruggs were the major influence on me when I was growing up. I was around seven years old when I first saw them, and there were two or three more times after that. It had a huge impact on me. I remember the warmth of the auditorium, I remember the smell of the popcorn, I remember the outfits they were wearing. It’s still all very vivid to me, and it’s still influencing me 50 years later.” The Historic Earle Theatre, with its period charm, intimate setting, and freshly popped popcorn, is the perfect place to experience this historic band.
