Portraits of Surry County old-time music icons line the walls of the Earle. An audio guided tour with Kelly Epperson of radio station WPAQ 740 AM will enhance your visit. The audio guides have the music and the voices of the musicians featured on the walls. Kelly also shares personal stories of each one. *Surry County Music*, a documentary filmed by UNC-TV as part of its Folkways Series, and hosted by four time Grammy Award winner David Holt, runs continuously in the music hall. There are exhibits featuring memorabilia of Surry County old-time music masters as well as artifacts from WPAQ. The venue is part of the Blue Ridge Music Trails Project of the Blue Ridge National Heritage Area.
